Nominations are invited for the Fifth THERMAX-ASSET awards for the best Ph.D. / M.Tech. / M.Phil. thesis in the area of Separation Science and Technology. Degree should have been awarded by an Indian University / Deemed University (recognized by UGC) during the period of 1st January 2014 to 31st December 2015. The award carries a medal, citation and Rs.15,000/- in cash for Ph.D. thesis and Rs. 10,000/- in cash for M.Tech. / M.Phil. thesis.

The nominations (format available at www.asset.org.in) should be sent to Dr. S. Jeyakumar, Secretary, ASSET on i) sjkumar@barc.gov.in and ii) assetawards2015@gmail.com. It is necessary to send a copy of the synopsis along with complete list of publications / patents related to the thesis (Five best reprints should also be attached). Selection of the awardees will be made by a panel of experts constituted by ASSET and the decision of the experts' panel will be final and binding.

Awards will be conferred during the Annual General Body Meeting of ASSET to be held during the month of May 2016 at IIT, Guwahati during SESTEC-2016 Symposium. Financial support for lodging, boarding and round trip train travel to Guwahati will be provided by ASSET.
