Nominations are invited for the 13th THERMAX-ASSET Awards for the best Ph.D. thesis and M.Tech. or M.Phil. Thesis, separately. Thesis should be in the area of Separation Science and Technology. Degrees should have been awarded by an Indian University / Deemed University (recognized by UGC) during the period of 1st January 2022 to 31st December 2023. The awards carry a medal, citation and Rs.15,000/- in cash for Ph.D. thesis and Rs. 10,000/- in cash for M.Tech. / M.Phil. thesis.

Documents to be sent along with nomination form are:

- 1. Synopsis of the Thesis
- 2. List of Publications/patents
- 3. Reprints of best five publications

Selection of the awardees will be made by a panel of experts constituted by ASSET and the decision of the experts' panel will be final and binding.

Financial support for lodging, boarding and round trip train travel

(3 AC) to Mumbai will be provided by ASSET to the Awardees.
